The group members stated that they would like to see different formatting as well. Nichole Smith stated that she would work together on putting a rough draft together for the coalition members to interpret at the next meeting. She also stated that a lot of the information that Kim Jones had discussed from the last meeting on the data collection points were missing and needed to be added to the new survey instrument. Pam Crawford suggested that we email something prior to the meeting for the coalition members to look over before the next meeting. Matt Brewster said we should be able to accommodate that before the next meeting.
